INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 94—Willard Murray. An act to amend Section 84750 of, and to add Section 84750.5 to, the Education Code, relating to community colleges.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 95—Valerie Brown, Alpert, Bowen, Davis, Ducheny, Escutia, Friedman, Mazzoni, and Speier, (Senator Peace, coauthor). An act to amend Sections 207, 208, 209, 664, 667.71, 667.8, and 2933.5 of the Penal Code, relating to crimes.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 96—Hannigan. An act to add Section 65964 to the Government Code, relating to development projects.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 97—Conroy. An act to add and repeal Section 31000.05 of the Government Code, relating to county contracts, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 98—Olberg. An act to add Section 11450.02 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to aid to families with dependent children.

ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 4—Hannigan. A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending subdivision (c) of Section 8 and subdivision (d) of Section 12 of Article IV thereof, relating to fiscal affairs.
