ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 115—McDonald. An act to amend Section 10086.5 of the Insurance Code, relating to earthquake insurance.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 116—Speier. An act to add and repeal Section 7550.5 of the Government Code, relating to legislative oversight, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 117—Knowles. An act to add Section 4189 to, to repeal Section 3950.1 of, to repeal Chapter 9 (commencing with Section 2780) of Division 3 of, and to repeal and add Chapter 10 (commencing with Section 4800) of Part 3 of Division 4 of, the Fish and Game Code, and to repeal Sections 1, 7, 8, and 9 of the California Wildlife Protection Act of 1990, relating to wildlife, and making an appropriation therefor.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 118—Conroy. An act to add Sections 2120, 3804.2, 3952, 4023, 4133, 4673, 4876, 5321, 5421, and 5513 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 119—Baca. An act to amend Section 854 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.
