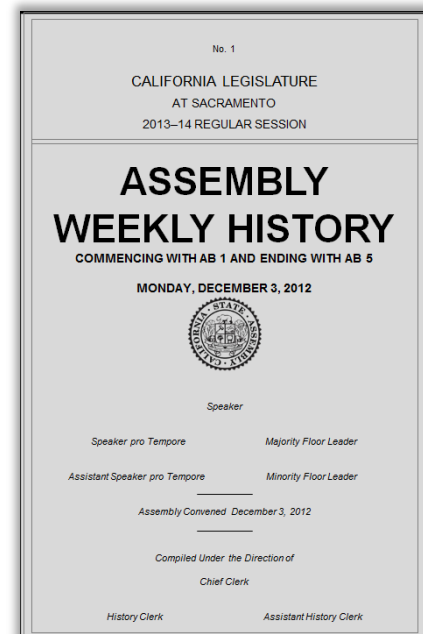


QUICK FACT SHEET THE ASSEMBLY HISTORY
