**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1609—Muratsuchi. An act to add Section 42238.023 to the Education Code, relating to education finance, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1610—Lackey. An act to amend Section 17564 of the Government Code, relating to state mandates.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1611—Davies (Coauthor: Nguyen). An act to add Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 8765) to Division 7.8 of the Public Resources Code, relating to oil spills.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1612—Burke. An act to add Sections 17158.3 and 24308.3 to the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1613—Irwin (Principal coauthors: Gipson and Ting) (Coauthors: Levine, Salas, and Villapudua) (Coauthors: Senators Becker, Glazer, and Umberg). An act to add Section 786.5 to the Penal Code, relating to theft.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1614—Muratsuchi. An act to amend Sections 2574, 41376.1, 42238.02, and 42287 of, to amend, repeal, and add Section 41339.2 of, and to add Section 42238.015 to, the Education Code, relating to education finance.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1615—Ting. An act to amend Sections 50807 and 50811 of, and to amend the heading of Chapter 11.8 (commencing with Section 50811) of Part 2 of Division 31 of, the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Sections 11403.2, 16523, and 16523.1 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to foster care.
