**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF  
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 91—Feuer.** An act to add and repeal Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 23700) of Division 11.5 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 92—De León.** An act relating to state claims and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 93—De León.** An act relating to the payment of claims against the state, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 94—Evans.** An act to amend Section 7260 of the Government Code, to amend Sections 37002, 37022, 37034, and 37035 of the Public Resources Code, and to amend Sections 17053.30 and 23630 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to conservation.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 95—Torlakson.** An act to amend Section 49430.5 of the Education Code, relating to school meals, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 96—Ruskin.** An act to amend Section 25299.105 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to public health.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 97—Torlakson.** An act to amend and repeal Section 60605 of, and to add and repeal Section 60605.4 of, the Education Code, relating to school curriculum.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 98—De La Torre (Coauthors: Brownley, Caballero, Carter, Chesbro, Ma, Monning, Ruskin, Salas, Skinner, Torlakson, Torres, and Yamada) (Coauthors: Senators Hancock, Negrete McLeod, and Wolk).** An act to add Section 10123.865 to the Insurance Code, relating to health care coverage.
