ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Daucher and Rod Pacheco. An act to add Section 40714.7 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to electricity.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Keeley. An act to amend Sections 335 and 341.2 of, to add Section 352 to, and to repeal and add Sections 337 and 338 of, the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
