ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 225—Grayson. An act to add Section 10084.2 to the Business and Professions Code, relating to property.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 226—Ramos. An act to add Article 2.8 (commencing with Section 92617) to Chapter 6 of Part 57 of Division 9 of Title 3 of the Education Code, relating to the University of California.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 227—Sanchez. An act to add Part 10 (commencing with Section 22990) to Division 5 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to state employment.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 228—Wilson and Weber (Coauthors: Boerner Horvath, Megan Dahle, Davies, Stephanie Nguyen, Luz Rivas, Blanca Rubio, and Waldron) (Coauthor: Senator Nguyen). An act to add Section 131022 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to public health.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 229—Joe Patterson. An act to amend Sections 667.1, 667.5, and 1170.125 of the Penal Code, relating to violent felonies.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 230—Reyes. An act to amend Section 35292.6 of the Education Code, relating to menstrual products.
