The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 231—Chen. An act to amend Sections 600, 5510, 7510, 9411, and 12460 of the Corporations Code, relating to corporations.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 232—Aguilar-Curry. An act to add and repeal Sections 4980.11, 4996.16.1, and 4999.23 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 233—Wilson. An act to add Chapter 6.4 (commencing with Section 51045) to Part 1 of Division 1 of Title 5 of the Government Code, relating to local government.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 234—Bauer-Kahan. An act relating to solid waste.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 235—Blanca Rubio. An act relating to human trafficking.
