**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF  
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 109—Feuer.** An act to add and repeal Section 5420 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to outdoor advertising.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 110—Smyth (Coauthor: Senator Runner).** An act to amend Section 33204.4 of the Public Resources Code, relating to parks and open space.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 111—Niello (Coauthors: DeVore and Jeffries) (Coauthors: Senators Cox, Huff, and Runner).** An act to amend Section 17144.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 112—Beall.** An act to amend Sections 100001.5, 100161, 100163, and 100164 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to transportation.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 113—Portantino.** An act to add Section 118.2 to the Streets and Highways Code, relating to highways, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 114—Carter.** An act to add Section 237 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to juveniles.
