**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 177—Chávez.** An act to add Section 11174.2 to the Penal Code, relating to child abuse and neglect.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 178—Eggman.** An act to amend Section 14501 of the Public Resources Code, relating to recycling.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 179—Cervantes.** An act to amend Section 14502 of, and to add Sections 14506.7 and 14516 to, the Government Code, relating to transportation.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 180—Wood (Coauthor: Senator Hernandez).** An act to amend Section 14102.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to Medi-Cal.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 181—Lackey (Principal coauthor: Senator Cannella) (Coauthors: Chávez, Flora, Gallagher, Cristina Garcia, and Voepel) (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Vidak, and Wilk). An act to amend Section 17053.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.
