An act to amend Sections 79720, 79720.1, 79720.2, 79720.3, 79720.4, 79720.6, 79721, 79722, 79723, 79731, 79740, 79750, 79755, 79756, 79757, 79758, 79759, 79759.5, 79760, 79760.5, 79770, 79780, 79781, 79784, 79810, and 79824 of the Water Code, and to amend Section 8 of Chapter 126 of the Statutes of 2010, relating to the Safe, Clean, and Reliable Drinking Water Supply Act of 2012.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 158—Halderman. An act to amend Section 3294 of, and to add Section 3333.8 to, the Civil Code, relating to civil damages.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 159—Beall. An act to amend Section 1506.3 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to community care facilities.
