INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 169—Levine. An act to add Section 6530.5 to the Government Code, relating to joint powers authorities.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 170—Saldana. An act to add Section 8238 to the Education Code, relating to child care.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 171—Beall. An act to amend Section 69740 of the Education Code, relating to student financial aid.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 172—Bass. An act to add and repeal Chapter 1.5 (commencing with Section 16040) of Part 4 of Division 9 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to foster care, and making an appropriation therefor.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 173—Alarcon and Dymally. An act to amend Sections 41506 and 52890 of, to add Section 52380.5 to, to add Article 7 (commencing with Section 52900) to Chapter 12 of, and to add Chapter 6.7 (commencing with Section 52076) to, Part 28 of Division 4 of Title 2 of, the Education Code, relating to academic performance, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
