ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 280—Holden (Principal coauthor: Senator Durazo) (Coauthors: Bryan, Wendy Carrillo, Gipson, Kalra, and Weber). An act to add Article 7 (commencing with Section 2697) to Chapter 4 of Title 1 of Part 3 of the Penal Code, relating to segregated confinement.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 281—Grayson and Robert Rivas. An act to amend Section 65913.3 of the Government Code, relating to planning and zoning.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 282—Aguiar-Curry. An act to amend Section 2914 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 283—Jim Patterson. An act to amend Section 5845 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to mental health.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 284—Joe Patterson. An act to amend Section 50408 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to housing.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 285—Luz Rivas (Principal coauthors: Calderon and Ward) (Principal coauthors: Senators Cortese and Gonzalez) (Coauthors: Boerner Horvath and Davies). An act to amend Sections 51210 and 51220 of the Education Code, relating to pupil instruction.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 286—Wood. An act to amend Section 281.6 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to communications.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 287—Garcia. An act to add Sections 16428.87 and 16428.88 to the Government Code, and to amend Sections 39712 and 39720 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to greenhouse gases.
