**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
 ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 189—Eng (Coauthors: Fong, Mendoza, Swanson, and Torres). An act to amend Section 52612 of, and to add Section 52618 to, the Education Code, relating to adult education.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 190—Wieckowski. An act to add Section 1463.29 to the Penal Code, relating to fines.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 191—Bill Berryhill and Galgiani (Principal coauthor: Olsen) (Principal coauthors: Senators Berryhill and Cannella). An act to repeal and add Section 96.11 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to local government finance, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 192—Logue. An act to add Section 10752.3 to the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to public safety, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 14—Silva (Coauthors: Cook, Hagman, Jeffries, and Wagner) (Coauthor: Senator Fuller). A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending Section 8 of Article V thereof, relating to the Governor's powers.
