**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 187—Bonta. An act to amend Section 14094.3 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to children’s services.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 188—Cristina Garcia. An act to amend Section 8223 of the Education Code, relating to child care.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 189—Bloom. An act to add Chapter 9.2 (commencing with Section 8758) to Division 1 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to state government.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 190—Harper. An act to repeal Chapter 5.3 (commencing with Section 42280) of Part 3 of Division 30 of the Public Resources Code, and to repeal Section 2 of Chapter 850 of the Statutes of 2014, relating to solid waste, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 191—Harper. An act to amend Sections 42283 and 42283.7 of the Public Resources Code, relating to solid waste, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
