**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 343—Pacheco.** An act to amend Section 7920.500 of the Government Code, relating to public records.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 344—Valencia.** An act to amend Section 25000.2 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 345—Jackson.** An act to add Section 3075.2 to the Labor Code, relating to apprenticeship.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 346—Nguyen.** An act to amend Sections 12300.1 and 12309.1 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to in-home supportive services.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 347—Kalra.** An act to amend Sections 32255, 32255.1, 32255.3, 32255.4, 32255.5, and 33315 of, and to add Section 32255.7 to, the Education Code, relating to pupil instruction.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 348—Krell.** An act to amend Section 5887 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to behavioral health.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 349—Dixon.** An act to amend Section 11465 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to foster care.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 350—Bonta.** An act to add Section 1367.73 to the Health and Safety Code, to add Section 10120.45 to the Insurance Code, and to amend Section 14132 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to health care coverage.
