The following bill was introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 12—Bill Berryhill and Galgiani (Principal coauthor: Olsen) (Principal coauthors: Senators Berryhill and Cannella). An act to repeal and add Section 96.11 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to local government finance, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
