**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 37—Charles Calderon and Nestande. An act to add and repeal Section 21099 of the Public Resources Code, relating to the environment, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 38—Audra Strickland. An act to repeal and add Section 1781 of the Civil Code, and to add Section 383 to, and to repeal and add Section 382 of, the Code of Civil Procedure, relating to civil actions.
