INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 52—John Campbell. An act to add Section 743.5 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to energy, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 53—Reyes. An act to add Article 4 (commencing with Section 15350) to Chapter 1 of Part 6.7 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to energy resources, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 54—Wright. An act to add Section 9601.5 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to electricity, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 55—Rod Pacheco, Cogdill, Daucher, and Zettel (Principal coauthor: Senator Battin). An act to add Sections 21080.12 and 40710.5 to the Public Resources Code, relating to energy.
