**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 40—Niello.** An act to amend Section 3294 of, and to add Section 3333.8 to, the Civil Code, relating to civil damages.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 41—Nava (Coauthors: Ammiano, Beall, Blumenfield, Chesbro, Evans, Furutani, Hill, Huffman, Jones, Monning, Salas, Saldaña, and Torlakson).** An act to add Part 21 (commencing with Section 42001) to Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 42—Jeffries (Coauthors: Bill Berryhill, Tom Berryhill, Conway, Cook, DeVore, Emmerson, Fletcher, Gaines, Garrick, Gilmore, Harkey, Logue, Miller, Nestande, Niello, Nielsen, Silva, Smyth, Tran, and Villines) (Coauthors: Senators Aanestad, Ashburn, Cogdill, Dutton, Harman, Hollingsworth, Huff, Runner, Strickland, and Wyland).** An act to amend Section 8589.19 of, and to add Section 8589.24 to, the Government Code, relating to firefighting, and making an appropriation therefor.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 43—Audra Strickland.** An act to add Section 11250.5 to the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to public social services.
