INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 67—Negrete McLeod. An act to add Section 12087.5 to the Government Code, relating to energy resources, and making an appropriation therefor.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 68—Firebaugh (Coauthors: Senators Escutia, Perata, and Torlakson). An act to add Sections 25011 and 25523.5 to the Public Resources Code, relating to energy resources.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 69—La Suer. An act to add Section 9616 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 70—La Suer. An act to add Section 363.7 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 71—La Suer. An act to add Section 63025.3 to the Government Code, relating to the infrastructure development, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 72—La Suer. An act to add Section 6501.4 to the Public Resources Code, relating to energy facilities, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
