ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 21—Villines. An act to add Sections 5003.16 and 5080.41 to the Public Resources Code, to amend Section 9 of Chapter 731 of the Statutes of 1998, and to amend Section 10 of Chapter 974 of the Statutes of 2002, relating to state property, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
