RE: Bargaining Unit 10, Represented by the California Association of Professional Scientists (CAPS), State's Implementation Plan

Dear Senators McGuire and Jones, and Assembly Members Rivas and Gallagher:

CalHR began negotiations for a successor Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agreement with CAPS in March 2020. Salary increases were agreed to in 2021 via a side letter agreement approved by the Legislature while the State continued to negotiate in good faith throughout 2023. The parties engaged in mediation from November 8, 2023, to December 13, 2023. On the last day of mediation, CAPS expressed its intent to hold unwaveringly to its bargaining demands, showing no movement toward reaching agreement. As a result, the State presented CAPS with its last, best, and final offer (LBFO) on December 19, 2023, as provided under the Ralph C. Dills Act. The State received CAPS' rejection of the LBFO on December 21, 2023.

Having reached impasse in negotiations for a successor MOU, the State must exercise its right as directed by Government Code section 3517.8 to implement any or all of the terms in the LBFO¹. The State's Implementation Plan, outlined in the attached chart is necessary to maintain efficient state operations until a successor MOU agreement is reached. Provisions of the implemented terms such as vacation, sick, and parental leave as well as holiday credit, and health and welfare provisions for disability and death benefits that provide greater benefit than state law require Legislative approval. Without Legislative approval, those benefits will revert to general provisions of state law.

With this transmittal, the State also seeks Legislative approval of a three percent (3%) general salary increase (GSI) for BU 10 employees effective January 1, 2024. The State believes this is necessary to address the growing gap between salary increases afforded to other state employees that haven't been similarly extended to BU 10 employees because of the impasse. The increase reflects what the State can support in a time of budget constraints and reflects the Administration's approach to supporting the State's workforce while maintaining fiscal responsibility.

Despite the current bargaining impasse, the State prefers to return to the table to mutually negotiate a multi-year agreement that addresses many of the priorities of both the State and BU 10, but until then, we propose to maintain as much of the status quo as possible and provide the three percent (3%) GSI.

Finally, attached is a legislative and fiscal summary. The Legislative Analyst will be forwarded a copy for analysis, and the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the Assembly will be forwarded copies to note them as available for review in the Daily Journals.

Members of the Assembly: As directed by the Joint Legislative Audit Committee, my office conducted an audit of the cannabis-permitting processes at the counties of Monterey and Santa Barbara and the cities of Fresno, Sacramento, San Diego, and South Lake Tahoe. In general, we determined that cities and counties (local jurisdictions) could improve their cannabis-permitting processes to increase public confidence and mitigate the risks of corruption.

Our review found that the local jurisdictions we reviewed did not always include several best practices in their permitting policies that help to ensure fairness and prevent conflicts of interest, abuse, and favoritism. Only two of the local jurisdictions we reviewed used blind scoring of applications, wherein the identities of the applicants are kept from those reviewing and scoring applications, and four of the local jurisdictions we reviewed did not require that all individuals involved in reviewing applications agree to impartiality statements. My office also found that all six of the local jurisdictions we reviewed were inconsistent in following key steps that their permitting policies required. For example, records at each of the six jurisdictions lacked documentation to demonstrate that all applicants had passed their required background checks.

Through Proposition 64, California's voters legalized the nonmedical use of cannabis by adults age 21 and older. Because the resulting state law ensures that local jurisdictions retain significant control over the authorization and regulation of cannabis businesses within their jurisdiction, we have made recommendations generally and identified best practices for all local jurisdictions that may permit cannabis businesses. Such best practices may help local jurisdictions bolster the public's confidence in the fairness and transparency of their permitting processes.
