INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Torrico. An act to amend Sections 20814 and 20816 of, and to add Sections 20814.5 and 31453.7 to, the Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Torrico. An act to add Article 3 (commencing with Section 20085) to Chapter 1 of Part 3 of Division 5 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6—Evans and Torrico. An act relating to public employees' retirement.
