The following veto message from the Governor was received by the Secretary of State pursuant to Article IV, Section 10(b)(4) of the Constitution of the State of California, and ordered printed in the Journal:

Veto Message—Assembly Bill No. 10

Governor’s Office, Sacramento
May 4, 2016

To the Members of the California State Assembly:

I am returning Assembly Bill X2 10 without my signature.

This bill would permit, on a blanket basis, tobacco taxation at the discretion of local counties.

Although California has one of the lowest cigarette tax rates in the nation, I am reluctant to approve this measure in view of all the taxes being proposed for the 2016 ballot.
