**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 10—Hertzberg. An act to add Section 25525.3 to the Public Resources Code, relating to electrical generation, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 11—Wright. An act to add Section 9601.5 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to electricity, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 12—Simitian. An act to amend Section 31007.5 of the Water Code, relating to water.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 13—Hollingsworth. An act to add Section 625.5 to the Public Utilities Code, relating to eminent domain.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 14—Canciamilla. An act to amend Sections 216, 222, and 228 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public utilities.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 15—Rod Pacheco. An act to add Sections 17053.82 and 23682 to the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 16—Briggs and Matthews (Coauthors: Cedillo and Florez). An act to add and repeal Section 6357.1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.
