**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bill was introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Wilk (Coauthor: Conway). An act to amend Sections 1389.1, 1389.2, 1389.4, 1389.5, and 1389.8 of, to add Section 1366.30 to, and to add Chapter 9 (commencing with Section 127670) to Part 2 of Division 107 of, the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Sections 10113.95, 10119.1, 10119.3, 10270.98, 10273.4, 10273.6, and 10291.5 of, to add Section 10128.60 to, and to repeal Section 10270.99 of, the Insurance Code, relating to health care.
