PRAYER

Every true teacher and genuine spiritual tradition recognizes this reality and has tried to share this awareness in so very many ways. The Persian Spiritual Poet, Rumi, beautifully shared, "Beyond our ideas of good and bad, there is a Field. I will meet you there."

Rumi was saying, "Beyond our judgements of good and bad, mine and yours, self and others, there is a place; a place where we are no longer centered on ourselves; where we realize we are one Humanity. I will meet you there."
