SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS**

**SENATE BILL NO. 3**—An act to amend, repeal, and add Sections 100501 and 100503 of, and to add and repeal Sections 100504.5 and 100504.6 of, the Government Code, to amend, repeal, and add Section 1366.6 of, and to add and repeal Section 1399.864 of, the Health and Safety Code, to amend, repeal, and add Section 10112.3 of, and to add and repeal Section 10961 of, the Insurance Code, and to add and repeal Section 14005.70 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to health care coverage.

Bill read second time, and ordered to third reading.
