**Governor’s Message—Assembly Bills Nos. 19, 26, 27, and 28**

Governor’s Office, Sacramento

June 28, 2011

*To the Members of the California State Assembly:*

Assembly Bills 19, 26, 27 and 28 from the First Extraordinary Session, in my opinion, constitute emergency bills within the meaning of that term as used in Section 12 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of California, the consideration of which should not await the final enactment of the Budget Bill.

I, therefore, recommend consideration of Assembly Bills 19, 26, 27 and 28 from the First Extraordinary Session as emergency measures.
