**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 32—Jeffries. An act to amend Sections 5080.31 and 5080.40 of, and to add Section 5080.30.5 to, the Public Resources Code, relating to state parks.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 33—Jeffries. An act to add Section 5023.7 to the Penal Code, relating to corrections.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 34—Jeffries. An act to add Section 19993.9 to the Government Code, relating to state-owned motor vehicles.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 35—Jeffries. An act to amend Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to highways.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 36—Jeffries. An act relating to the Lieutenant Governor.

ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 1—Jeffries. A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending, repealing, and adding Sections 3, 8, 10, 11, and 12 of Article IV thereof, by amending, repealing, and adding Section 6 of Article XIX thereof, and by amending, repealing, and adding Section 1 of Article XIXA thereof, relating to legislative sessions.

ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 2—Jeffries. A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending Section 9 of Article II thereof, and by amending Sections 3, 4, 10, and 11 of Article IV thereof, relating to the Legislature.
