**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF  
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Roger Hernández (Coauthor: Eduardo Garcia).** An act to amend Section 50199.7 of the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Sections 12206, 17058, and 23610.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6—Roger Hernández and Eduardo Garcia.** An act to add Section 75218 to the Public Resources Code, relating to greenhouse gases.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 7—Nazarian.** An act to amend Section 39719 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to public transit, and making an appropriation therefor.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 8—Chiu and Bloom.** An act to amend, repeal, and add Sections 6051.8 and 6201.8 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, and making an appropriation therefor, to take effect immediately, tax levy.
