ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 83—Wright. An act to amend Sections 367, 368, 369, 377, 840, 841, 842, 843, 846, 846.2, 1731, and 9601 of, and to add Sections 367.2, 451.1, and 848 to, the Public Utilities Code and to amend Sections 80002 and 80110 of the Water Code, relating to energy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 84—Strom-Martin. An act to amend Sections 32932, 32942, 32952, 32955, and 32960 of, and to repeal Section 32909 of, the Financial Code, relating to energy efficiency, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
