To the Assembly of the State of California:

I have received notice that Judy Chu, Member of the California State Board of Equalization, Fourth District, has been elected to Congress effective July 14, 2009, and subsequently resigned from her office as a member of the Board on July 15, 2009. Under applicable law, this resignation creates an immediate vacancy in the office of the member of the California State Board of Equalization, Fourth District, on the date of her resignation.

Having received such notice, and pursuant to the powers vested in me by Article V of the California Constitution and Section 1775 of the California Government Code, I hereby nominate the following person to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term:

Jerome Horton
Inglewood, California 90302
Former Member of the California State Assembly

Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of this state, said nomination shall be effective on the date of the incumbent’s resignation. As stated in Section 1775 of the Government Code, the chief deputy to the member of the California State Board of Equalization, Fourth District, shall discharge the duties of that office prior to the time the vacancy is filled pursuant to Article V of the California Constitution.
