INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced and read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3—Benoit (Coauthors: Cogdill and Sharon Runner) (Coauthor: Senator Harman). An act to add Section 5028.5 to the Penal Code, relating to undocumented criminal aliens.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Parra, Bermudez, and Spitzer. An act to add Chapter 3.22 (commencing with Section 15819.39), and Chapter 3.23 (commencing with Section 15819.43) to Part 10b of Division 3 of Title 2 of, the Government Code, and to add Chapter 9.8 (commencing with Section 6270) to Title 7 of Part 3 of the Penal Code, relating to prisons, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Bermudez, Sharon Runner, and Spitzer. An act to add Chapter 3.26 (commencing with Section 15819.55) to Part 10b of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to corrections, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
