**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 11—Sharon Runner.** An act to add Part 6 (commencing with Section 16000) to the Penal Code, relating to financing local detention facilities, by providing the funds necessary through the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and by providing the handling and disposition of those funds, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
