RE: Tentative Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for Bargaining Unit 5, California Association of Highway Patrolmen

Dear Senators McGuire and Jones and Assembly Members Rivas and Gallagher:

The California Department of Human Resources has reached a new Tentative Agreement/MOU with the union representing Bargaining Unit (BU) 5—California Association of Highway Patrolmen. Upon approval by the Legislature and the Governor, and ratification by employee membership, the agreement will be effective through June 30, 2027. In accordance with Government Code Sections 3517.5, 19829.5, and Senate Rule 29.4, please accept the attached Tentative Agreement/MOU, including legislative and fiscal summaries.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 19827, the Tentative Agreement/MOU contains the general salary increase for BU 5, effective July 1, 2024. The agreement also includes targeted recruitment and retention incentives.

Additionally, the Tentative Agreement/MOU establishes a one-time reimbursement for external vest carriers and implements a business and travel expense reimbursement program that includes adopting the federal standard meal and incidental expense and lodging rates.

Finally, this agreement carries forward language from previous agreements and makes various other benefit and labor changes. The Tentative Agreement/MOU and summaries can also be found by going to the following link: CalHR Bargaining Unit 5 Contract Webpage.
