**CONSIDERATION OF DAILY FILE
SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS**

SENATE BILL NO. 594—An act to amend Sections 21500, 21601, and 21621 of, to add Section 22002 to, and to add and repeal Section 22000.1 of, and Chapter 1.5 (commencing with Section 8160) to Part 1 of Division 8 of, the Elections Code, relating to elections, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
