PROCLAMATION OF THE GOVERNOR

Assistant Speaker pro Tempore Hall directed the Clerk to read the following Proclamation of the Governor convening the Legislature in extraordinary session:

A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS an extraordinary occasion has arisen and now exists requiring that the Legislature of the State of California be convened in extraordinary session; now therefore,

- I, ARNOLD SCHWARZENEGGER, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Section 3(b) Article IV of the Constitution of the State of California, do hereby convene the Legislature of the State of California to meet in extraordinary session at Sacramento, California on the 20th day of August 2009, at a time to be determined, for the following purpose and to legislate upon the following subject no later than October 5, 2009:
 - 1. To consider and act upon legislation to address the federal Race to the Top eligibility requirements and guidelines, and other changes necessary to secure federal funding.
