Dear Mr. Wilson: On August 31, 2005 I attempted to add on as an "Aye" vote for Senator Martha Escutia's Senate Bill 12, an act related to school nutrition. When the initial vote on the floor took place, I was regrettably at a previously scheduled medical appointment, thus missing the vote.

As a co-author of this measure and as someone who voted for SB 12 previously in the Assembly Health Committee, I was dismayed to have missed the vote and went back to the floor after session to add-on as an "Aye" vote. I later learned that my attempt to add on had not been officially recorded as a part of the vote total.

I respectfully request that this letter be published in the daily journal as an official part of the Assembly's record, indicating my support for this measure and this issue.
