## INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Nakanishi.** An act to amend Sections 17072, 17215, and 19184 of, to amend and repeal Sections 17131.4, 17131.5, 17215.1, and 17215.4 of, and to add Sections 17138.5, 17138.6, and 17216 to, the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Nakanishi.** An act to add and repeal Sections 17053.77 and 23677 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6—Nakanishi.** An act to amend Section 3523 of the Business and Professions Code, and to add Article 6 (commencing with Section 128559) to Chapter 5 of Part 3 of Division 107 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to physician assistants.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 7—Nakanishi.** An act to amend Section 12725 of the Insurance Code, relating to health care coverage.
