FIRST READING OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were read the first time:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1—Hart and Aguiar-Curry (Principal coauthors: Addis, Bennett, Bryan, Jackson, Kalra, Lee, and Wood). An act to amend Sections 25354.2, 25367, 25371, and 25372.2 of, to add Sections 25354.4 and 25354.6 to, and to repeal and add Section 25373 of, the Public Resources Code, relating to energy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2—Lackey. An act to amend Sections 7360, 7362, 7363, and 7364 of, and to add Section 7374 to, the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3—Gallagher (Coauthors: Alanis, Chen, Megan Dahle, Dixon, Lackey, Jim Patterson, Joe Patterson, Sanchez, and Ta). An act to amend Section 43013.2 of, and to add Sections 38562.1 and 43830.5 to, the Health and Safety Code, relating to air pollution.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4—Joe Patterson (Coauthors: Alanis, Chen, Davies, Dixon, Gallagher, Lackey, and Ta). An act to add Section 39617.2 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to air resources.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5—Lackey (Coauthors: Alanis, Chen, Megan Dahle, Davies, Dixon, Gallagher, Joe Patterson, and Ta). An act to add Section 39719.4 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to high-speed rail.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6—Lackey (Coauthors: Alanis, Chen, Megan Dahle, Davies, Dixon, Gallagher, Joe Patterson, Ta, and Wallis). An act to amend Section 21189.81 of the Public Resources Code, relating to environmental quality.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 7—Dixon (Coauthors: Alanis, Chen, Megan Dahle, Davies, Flora, Gallagher, Lackey, Mathis, Joe Patterson, Sanchez, Ta, and Wallis). An act to add Section 25365 to the Public Resources Code, relating to energy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 8—Gipson. An act to add Section 39633 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to air pollution, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 9—Petrie-Norris. An act to add Section 43830.9 to the Health and Safety Code, and to add and repeal Section 25371.4 of the Public Resources Code, relating to energy, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
