**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF
ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1—Benoit. An act to repeal and add Sections 45103.1, 45103.5, 88003.1, and 88004.5 of the Education Code, and to add Section 3562.3 to the Government Code, relating to public education.

ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 1—Plescia. A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending Section 12 of Article IV thereof, by amending Section 3 of Article XIII A thereof, and by amending Section 6 of Article XIII B thereof, relating to state finances.
