**INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 56—Quirk.** An act to add Section 6254.31 to the Government Code, and to add Title 14 (commencing with Section 14350) to Part 4 of the Penal Code, relating to unmanned aircraft systems.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 57—Quirk.** An act relating to communications.

**ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 58—Rodriguez.** An act to amend Sections 32280, 32281, 32282, 32286, and 32288 of, to add Sections 32286.1, 32288.1, and 32289.5 to, and to repeal Section 32289 of, the Education Code, relating to school safety.
