Dear Chief Clerk: I am writing this letter to reinforce the intent of a letter sent to State Controller John Chiang in June regarding the 5.3% pay raise for California Legislators.

In addition to declining the 5.3% pay increase approved by the California Citizens Compensation Commission, which took effect December 2nd, I want to make it clear that I also want to decline the accompanying increase for in-session per diem.

My understanding is that the per diem rate will be increased from \$141.86 to \$163.00, and I would like my per diem maintained at the \$141.86/day rate. Thank you for your attention on this matter.
