INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 59—Swanson. An act to amend Section 12945.2 of the Government Code, relating to family and medical leave.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 60—Jeffries (Principal coauthor: Nestande) (Principal coauthor: Senator Emmerson) (Coauthors: Cook and Miller). An act to amend Section 1192.7 of the Penal Code, relating to sentencing.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 61—Jeffries. An act to add and repeal Chapter 6.2 (commencing with Section 1962) of Division 2.5 of the Streets and Highways Code, and to amend Sections 21251 and 21260 of the Vehicle Code, relating to neighborhood electric vehicles.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 62—Monning. An act to add Article 5.227 (commencing with Section 14168) to Chapter 7 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to Medi-Cal, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
