INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 81—Cunneen. An act to add and repeal Section 24216.6 of the Education Code, and to add and repeal Sections 17052.55, 17052.56, 23655, and 23656 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to schools.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 82—Cunneen. An act to add Section 1344.5 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to health.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 83—Cardenas. An act to add Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 16300) to Part 1 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to business licensing.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 84—Granolund. An act to add Section 53072.5 to the Government Code, relating to political committees.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 85—Granolund. An act to add Title 17 (commencing with Section 99000) to the Government Code, relating to Indian gambling.
