INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 84—Nakanishi. An act to amend Sections 17072, 17215, and 19184 of, and to add Sections 17138.5, 17138.6, and 17216 to, the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 85—Nakanishi. An act to add and repeal Sections 17053.77 and 23677 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 86—Lieu. An act to amend Sections 49431, 49431.2, and 49433.9 of the Education Code, relating to pupil nutrition.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 87—Blakeslee. An act to amend Section 25240 of, and to add Section 25244 to, the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 88—Lieu. An act to add Chapter 5.8 (commencing with Section 51950) to Part 28 of Division 4 of Title 2 of the Education Code, relating to pupil instruction.
