INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 146—Quirk-Silva. An act to amend Section 6539.5 of the Government Code, and to add Section 104.20 to the Streets and Highways Code, relating to state highways.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 147—Burke (Principal coauthor: Senator McGuire). An act to amend Sections 6015, 6203, and 7262 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 148—Quirk-Silva. An act to amend Section 65080 of the Government Code, relating to transportation.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 149—Cooper. An act to amend Section 39831.3 of the Education Code, relating to school transportation.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 150—Cooper. An act to amend Section 48645.5 of the Education Code, relating to pupils.
