INTRODUCTION OF ASSEMBLY BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 75—Hoover and Davies (Coauthor: Mathis). An act to amend Sections 459.5, 490.2, and 666 of the Penal Code, relating to crime.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 76—Davies. An act to amend Sections 186.9 and 186.10 of the Penal Code, relating to crimes.
